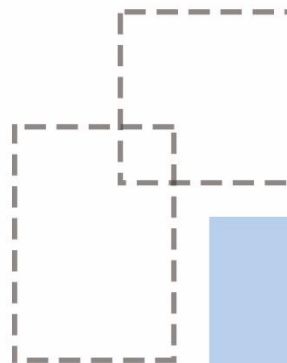

Keynote Speakers



Professor Shunsuke Managi

Distinguished Professor, Technology and Policy

& Director of Urban Institute, Kyushu University

Shunsuke Managi is the Distinguished Professor of Technology and Policy & Director of Urban Institute at the Kyushu University, Japan. He has been awarded several national research grants on topics such as urbanization, transportation, energy, climate change, sustainability, and population change. He has received several research fellowships from organizations such as the Helmholtz Association and Cheney Senior Fellowship and has served as an expert on energy and environmental policy. He is a lead author for the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), a coordinating lead author for the Intergovernmental Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (IPBES), a director for Inclusive Wealth Report 2018 (IWR 2018), an editor of “Economics of Disasters and Climate Change”, “Environmental Economic and Policy Studies”, and “Resource and Energy Economics” and on the editorial board for nine journals.



Professor Boqiang Lin

Dean, China Institute for studies in Energy Policy

Xiamen University

Boqiang Lin obtained his Ph. D in Economics from University of California at Santa Barbara, a 2007 “Chang Jiang Scholar” Distinguished Professor, and Dean of China Institute for Studies in Energy Policy, School of Management, Xiamen University; Editor, Energy Economics. He is also Vice Chairman of China Energy Society; Member of National Energy Consultation Committee under National Energy Commission; Member of National Energy Price Consultation Committee under National Development and Reform Commission; Member of Board of Directors of China National Petroleum Corporation and Chairman of Audit committee; Guest Commentator for China Central TV and China National Radio.

He has managed more than 120 research projects with funding of close to 10 million US dollars. He has published more than 370 academic papers in international and domestic energy and economics journals, with an h-index =42. He has 37 highly cited papers. He is co-author of several textbooks including Elementary Energy Economics, Advanced Energy Economics and Energy Finance. He has written each year about 60 commentaries and columns for top mainstream newspapers in China. He has regularly invited to speak at China Central TV and China National Radio and has strong media coverage in China on energy issues.



Professor Zhongxiang Zhang

Founding dean, Ma Yinchu School of Economics,

Tianjin University

Zhang ZhongXiang is the founding dean and distinguished university professor at Ma Yinchu School of Economics and Director of China Academy of Energy, Environmental and Industrial Economics, Tianjin University. He is co-editor of Environmental Economics and Policy Studies and International Journal of Public Policy, and serves on the editorial boards of ten other international journals. He is a Fellow of Asia and the Pacific Policy Society, Australia, and is on the Scientific Council of Paris-based IDDRI, Sciences Po.

He has authored over 200 publications in English, and authored and edited 21 books and special issues of international journals. He is consecutively ranked the 4th most cited scholar inside China in the field of economics and finance. He served as an expert to many national and international organizations and made the original contributions to a number of long-term goals and strategies that China is implementing, including the carbon intensity target for 2020, capping carbon emissions around 2030, and the establishment of the one belt one road initiative.
